Creating a SSIS Client Install CD

Overview

The CD burning process can be completed in less than ten minutes. Insert a blank CD in the SSIS server's CD drive. The server has a desktop icon labeled "SSIS Client Install CD-R". Double click on the "SSIS Client Install CD-R" icon. The CD burning process will then begin with a progress counter on the screen that counts up to 100%. After the CD burning is completed, the CD will be verified. The screen will display "Synchronizing Cache" while the CD is verified for approximately two minutes. At the end of the CD burning process, you will be instructed to press any key to continue, to exit the CD burning process.

After completing the CD burning process, manually eject the burned CD and physically label the CD.


Upon V14.3 implementation, this process will make both 32-bit and 64-bit installation available when burning the CD. The default install folder for 32-bit is C:\Program Files (x86)\DHS\SSIS\Client and the default install folder for 64-bit is C:\Program Files\DHS\SSIS\Client.

Burning a SSIS Client Installation CD


1. Insert a blank CD in the SSIS server's CD drive.
2. Double click on the SSIS Client Install CD-R to start the CD burning.



3. The CD burning process will be displayed, counting up to 100%. This portion of the process takes about five minutes to complete.



- The CD burning is verified. "Synchronizing Cache" displays on the screen for approximately two minutes.



- The CD burning is completed. Press any key to continue and to close the CD burning session. Eject and physically label the burned SSIS Client Installation CD.
