Complete option buttons w/keyboard navigation

Option buttons in SSIS display as circles that must be filled in to complete information. Users who navigate using a mouse can click on a button to fill it in and complete the field. Users who navigate using the keyboard accomplish this by pressing the space bar to move between options. The directions below are for keyboard navigation.

When a default selection does not display (i.e., no button is preselected):

1. Tab to the field with the option buttons (outlined with dotted lines)
2. Press the spacebar once and the first button fills.
3. Press the spacebar twice and the second button fills instead.
4. Press the spacebar again and the option buttons clear.

When there is a *default* entered, pressing the spacebar once selects the available option button. Pressing a second time returns to the default option button. The option buttons never clear.
