Understand the Child Findings Tab

The Child Findings tab displays on the Court Actions screen under the client's folder, under Case details, and on the Continuous placement screen's Review tab.

- The SSIS Court Actions screen has a second tab designed specifically for tracking Juvenile Court hearings regarding child out-of-home placements. Complete the Court Hearing tab and the Child Findings tab for the court hearing that sanctioned this placement.
- Entries on the Child Findings tab are tied to and required for the use of the SSIS IV-E submissions to MAXIS.
- To make a submission to MAXIS, the correct Continuous placement must be entered here.
- If you haven't entered the Continuous placement it does not display in the drop-down list on the Eligibility, Reimbursability and Submission to MAXIS screens.
