FAC-requested projects completed

Since 2009, agencies have used the Fiscal Advisory Committee (FAC) as an avenue for submitting project input and requests to SSIS through their FAC representatives. Here is a summary of projects completed or in development because of workers' feedback channeled through FAC members.

Completed Projects:

- Added the ability to claim for DD screenings through SSIS
- Added IV-E Claims folder to the Fiscal Details node
- Added "Service Year" to Service Arrangements, Payments, Health Care Claims, and IV-E Claims grids under Fiscal Details to separate Current Year, Last Year and Previous Years data
- Added subprograms to Workgroups for children's waivers
- Added a field for Special Studies to Client, Workgroup and Worker to give agencies and the state ways to identify specific populations.

Projects in Development:

- Add additional MA Eligibility data to SSIS from the Data Warehouse.
- Mark proofing records as reviewed and not claimable.
- Mark time records and payments as claimed in another system.
- Add the ability to search proofing outside of the claim batch or state report.

Note: Many other mandated projects and enhancements outside of the FAC process have also been completed.
