

MAPCY Scoring Adjustments

Domain U (Young Parents) which was previously only available in the EFC-SIL assessment tool, has been reworked and renamed to Domain I (Young Parents). Additionally, Domain I has been added to the Youth assessment tool.

Below is an explanation of the new domain's scope.

Youth Domains

I. Young Parents

Scope

This domain measures the support for a parenting foster youth living with their child(ren) in a family foster home. Northstar Care for Children permits the benefit to accommodate the board and care of a youth's child(ren) when an agency does not have placement, care and supervision responsibility for a youth's child(ren).

Extended Foster Care – Supervised Independent Living Domains

I. Young Parents

Scope

This domain measures the support for a parenting foster youth living with their child(ren) in an extended foster care – supervised independent living setting. Northstar Care for Children permits the benefit to accommodate the board and care of a youth's child(ren) when an agency does not have placement, care and supervision responsibility for a youth's child(ren).

Youth's Child Indicators

CHECK ONE:

a. Youth is not a parent or is a parent, but the child is not living with them.

b. Youth is a parent, and their child is living with them.

c. Youth is a parent, and two or more of their children are living with them.

Explain if you selected b or c

Domain I adds 0, 20 or 30 points to a youth's MAPCY score, resulting in more supports as they parent their child/ren.


Extraordinary Levels Calculation

The Extraordinary Levels calculation process has been adjusted to appropriately factor in the indicators of Education, Service Access I, Service Access II and Medically Dependent I.

For any/all Extraordinary Level requests explored and/or submitted by agencies that resulted in a "0" increase, users should set the Extraordinary Level request back to "Draft" status, rescore the tool, and if warranted, certify and submit to DHS for review and approval.

Tracking Extraordinary Levels Requests

In SSIS Release 15.3, there is a new way to track Extraordinary Level requests where “Clarification Needed” was requested by DHS and action is required by the agency. This new feature is located under Searches/Logs in the Extraordinary Levels Log. This enhancement will help users track the progress of an Extraordinary Levels request. After an Extraordinary Level request is sent to DHS for approval, it falls off the Approval Log. If “Clarification Needed” was requested by DHS, there was not a user-friendly way to track that. The new Extraordinary Levels Log now tracks those for users, in addition to those that are “Pending Agency Certification.”

MAPCY Text Cleanup

In SSIS Release 15.3, there are several text cleanups in each of the domains. These changes will not affect MAPCY scoring, but will be more descriptive and inclusive of several indicators geared towards “child” and “youth.”
