

SSIS Version 15.4 Pilot - Software Release Notes for November 2015

<u>MODULE</u>	<u>DESCRIPTION</u>
Adoption - County	Person > Documents: The document "MAPCY Notice of Post-Permanency Reassessment" has a "Net Increase" merge field on the Setup tab and in the document. This applies to situations when the reassessed amount is higher than the original amount.
Adoption - County	Commissioner Transition: The functionality to identify the next group of transition children has been redesigned to update the RCA and Income Offset amounts using the most recent finalized RCA Worksheet instead of the RCA Claims. This will correct the issue with the income offset information not being updated in the logs in DHS and SSIS Worker.
Architecture - SSIS	Searches/Logs main menu: The menu options are slightly rearranged, but no options were removed.
Child Maltreatment	Family Assessment track > Child Maltreatment Report screen: The message text when "Family Support Services Requested?" is incomplete now displays as "Family Support Services Requested" is required.
Child Maltreatment	Print > Child Protection Assessment Summary: The label "Services jointly agreed upon?" now displays as "Family Support Services Requested?" in the following three sections: 1. Maltreatment Conclusions 2. Open Workgroups Involving Clients 3. Closed Workgroups Involving Clients
Docs Case Notes & Chronology	Chronology: The print preview of the Chronology Summary Report now displays the correct text, or blank, that is entered in the "Format" field of a Documentation record.
Document Templates	Chronology Documents: The following documents have new or updated language regarding credit reports for youth in foster care ages 14 to 17: 1. Notice to Parent(s) Child in Voluntary Treatment Foster Care 2. Notice to Parent(s) American Indian Child in Voluntary Treatment 3. Notice to Parent Considering Voluntary Placement of a Child 4. Notice to Parent Considering Voluntary Placement of an Indian Child 5. Voluntary Out-of-Home Placement Agreement Consent-Indian Child 6. Voluntary Out-of-Home Placement Agreement Non-Indian Child 7. Voluntary Placement Agreement for Treatment American Indian Child 8. Voluntary Placement Agreement for Treatment Non-Indian Child
Document Templates	Person > Documents: Due to duplication on the Northstar Kinship RCA CT Benefit Agreement, the following text was removed from the signature section located above the dotted line: 1. Signature of Commissioner's Designated Agent 2. Name of Commissioner's Designated Agent 3. Date The signature information remains in the section designated for DHS use only.

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Exp. Statewide Search	Relationship/TPR tab: In the results grid for an agency, a "(county name) - connection is unavailable. Please try again later." message no longer occasionally displays instead of the relationship descriptions. Long relationship descriptions now display in the Relationship (Person 1 - Person 2)., The Relationship column may need to be resized to view the entire description.
Exp. Statewide Search	Copy Clients: Can be used to copy the client (s) directly into intakes or workgroups from the Workgroups tab in State Detail without error messages. The client (s) are no longer just copied into the agency database. Users no longer have to do another County Person Search to copy the participants into an intake or workgroup.
Fiscal -- Child Foster Care Report	Child Foster Care report: A design change was made so when special cost code "09 – ICPC Foster care increased rate," is used on a payment the full amount will be eligible for the Maximum amount for reimbursement calculations.
Fiscal -- Child Foster Care Report	The column "Payment Quarter" on the Child Foster Care Claims tab and the Child Foster Care Claims Search has been changed to "Payment Period" to more closely reflect how data will display on the Northstar Care Fiscal Reconciliation.
Fiscal -- Child Foster Care Report	Child Foster Care report: Legacy claim screen changed from a default of "Eligible MAPCY Level" to "Eligible DOC Points" to reflect that only DOC points were available for those claims.
Fiscal -- Child Foster Care Report	Security functions for creating and submitting the Child Foster Care Report have changed from Create IV-E Abstract Report and Submit IV-E Abstract Report to Create Child Foster Care Rpt and Submit Child Foster Care Rpt. Roles with these functions will update automatically.
Fiscal -- Child Foster Care Report	If your connection to SSIS DHS is down, you will be unable to generate the Child Foster Care Report. Message "SSIS DHS connection is down. Cannot generate the Child Foster Care Report. Try again later" will display.
Fiscal -- Child Foster Care Report	New Mange Grid Settings reports have been created to assist in balancing claim information to the Remittance Advice tab and the IV-E payment from FOD.
Fiscal -- Child Foster Care Report	Flipping Claims Functionality has been added to the Child Foster Care Claims Report. Release training documentation is available and includes examples of flipping claims.
Fiscal -- Claiming	Healthcare Claim Reporting: Claim Detail Report no longer opens expanded in the grid. The report can now be exported without error.
Fiscal -- Claiming	Healthcare Claiming - Payments - Not Automated Potentially Billable report: the optional column of "Exculsion Exists" is added to the report.
Fiscal -- Claiming	Healthcare Claim Reporting - Client Time Detail Report: "Exclusion" has been added as an optional column to the report. "Y" displays for Time Records when an Exclusion is entered from a Healthcare Claim or from Time Proofing of a healthcare claim batch.

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Fiscal -- Claiming	Enhancement: A new optional column for "Purpose" is available in the Time Proofing grid for Healthcare Claiming. The data comes from the "Purpose" field of the Time Record.
Fiscal -- Claiming	Healthcare Claiming - Claim Detail Report and Advanced Healthcare Claim Search: Calculated Age now calculates correctly, based on the dates of service and the client's DOB.
Fiscal -- Claiming Interface	Healthcare Claim Interface - Claim Rate Adjustment Reason Code HL - Gillette Increase Pay To Prov COS is added.
Fiscal -- Claiming Interface	Healthcare Claim Interface: DE - DME Legislative Increase was added to the Claim Rate Adjustment Reasons.
Fiscal -- MA Eligibility	Healthcare Eligibility>Do Not Claim Detail report: The Payments and Time Records sections display the payments and time records for the claimable services for the date range and claim category chosen on the setup screen.
Fiscal -- MA Eligibility	Healthcare Eligibility from MMIS> LTC Screenings: A new Results/Exit Reason code, "49 - Citizenship Verified", was created for AC and ECS clients when their citizenship is verified.
Fiscal -- MA Eligibility	Healthcare Eligibility>DD Screening Detail and LTC Screening Detail report: Removed "Report on" and "Ready to claim" section from Setup screen and made the Description field of the diagnosis code wrap the text.
Fiscal -- MA Eligibility	Tools>General Reports>Healthcare Eligibility>MH Rule 5 Eligibility and MH-TCM Eligibility reports: The "Diagnosis" field is expanded and wraps text when needed.
Fiscal -- MA Eligibility	Tools> General Reports>Healthcare Eligibility>MMIS DD Screenings and MMIS LTC Screenings reports: The report now displays ICD-10 code and description.
Fiscal -- Payment Interface	Payment Confirmation: For counties with AS/400 accounting systems that have updated their OS there was an issue with the Payment Confirmation receiving an error and not completing. With the 15.4 release the order of processing in the dex file has changed to work with all versions of OS.
Fiscal - RCA	RCA Claims grid: Optional grid column "Payment Quarter" is replaced by "Payment period".
Fiscal -- Service Arrangements	Use other vendors: The buttons are now enabled for Services: 180 - Treatment Foster Care, 181 - Child Family Foster Care, or 188 - Supervised independent living (18-20) with Special Cost Codes: 03 – Transportation, non-medical, 04 – Transportation, medical, 15 – Education transportation (Pre-K – 12 only), or 99 – Miscellaneous, unspecified.
Intake	Print > Child Protection Intake Summary: The label "Services Jointly Agreed Upon?" now displays as "Family Support Services Requested?" in the following sections: 1. Open Workgroups Involving Intake Clients 2. Closed Workgroups Involving Intake Clients
Licensing	Workgroup Detail: The printed report is displaying the correct value for the "SSIS Bus. Org. #" field. This field is in the "Bus. Org/Provider Information" section.

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MAPCY	Refined scoring for all children designed to more closely meet the targeted distribution, with an emphasis on scoring changes for children ages 0-6. This will tend to increase MAPCY levels for a number of children, focused on the 0-6 group in particular. Scoring changes in Domain F, to permit selection of parenting indicators for children age 3 and under (previously for these very young children, this domain was auto-scored and no indicators could be selected, no matter what the caregiver provided).
MAPCY	Text changes to strengthen the MAPCY assessment's inclusion of children's medical needs in Domains A, B, C and D. MAPCY templates are updated for this release. MAPCY's created prior to V15.4 that are draft/pending agency approval cannot be edited or approved. It is necessary to "Copy MAPCY", reset to draft and then delete the old version of the MAPCY. (Extraordinary Levels needs to be re-entered for new MAPCY) Previously approved MAPCY's can be reassessed or revised by using "Copy MAPCY" or "Create Revised MAPCY." (Extraordinary Levels need to be re-entered for new MAPCY)
MAPCY	Within the Documents folder under the Person node, two new MAPCY documents are available: MAPCY Assessment Notice-Caregiver FC to Permanency (RTF header required) Extraordinary Level Approval Notice FC to Permanency (No header required) These notices are used to notify pre-kinship and pre-adoptive parents that a MAPCY and/or Extraordinary Levels increase is approved for a child/youth transitioning from Legacy foster care to a Northstar Permanency option.
Person & Related (incl. Participant & Client Entry)	Relationships: Relationship code description changes now display for "Kin (tribal or ethnic)/previous foster parent - Kin (tribal or ethnic)/previous foster child" and "Former adoptive parent - Former adoptive child". Relationships display the gender-specific as well as the gender neutral description.
Person & Related (incl. Participant & Client Entry)	Client > Diagnosis screen: The "Description" field for an ICD-10-CM diagnosis now displays up to 100 characters. This affects the "Diagnosis" screen and grid, the "ICD-10 Code Search" screen and grid, and the "Advanced ICD-10 Code Search" screen and grid.
Person Search	Person Search: Name search results, when names are returned with the same last name but different first names, now by default, the names are sorted in ascending order sorted by A – Z. The Name column no longer needs to be sorted to reverse the order in the results grid.
Programs and Services	Programs and Services: When new County Settings are added or existing ones are edited the Effective Settings on the Summary now automatically refresh instead of remaining at the previous or default settings.

Programs and Services	<p>Programs & Services and Retention Period: The title of the CADI waiver program changed effective 10/01/2015 from Community Alternatives for Disabled Individuals to Community Access for Disability Inclusion. As a result, some of the BRASS Program Descriptions have changed. The Program Abbreviations have not changed because they are still appropriate.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Children's Services 173 - Child - Community Alternatives for Disabled Individuals now displays as 173 - Child - Community Access for Disability Inclusion. 2. Adult Services 673 - Adult - Community Alternatives for Disabled Individuals now displays as 673 - Adult - Community Access for Disability Inclusion. <p>The same changes were made in the descriptions in the Workgroup Type column in the Retention Period in County Preferences.</p>
Programs and Services	<p>Programs and Services: A new sub-program, "Adult - Essential Community Supports", was added to the Program dropdown list in Intake, creating workgroups, entering Contact/Activity and for Purge (Retention Period 10 Years from closing-can increase.). See Fiscal Release Training documents for additional information about the associated Services and Activities.</p>
Programs and Services	<p>HCPCS/Modifiers: The Billing information is updated, including adding the ECS waiver, on several records:</p> <p>H2015 - Community Living Assistance Services, in person - ECS waiver client only.</p> <p>H2016 - Community Living Assistance Services, remote - ECS waiver client only.</p> <p>S5120 - Chore services - AC, BI, CAC, CADI, DD, ECS, or EW waiver client.</p> <p>S5130 - Homemaker service - cleaning only (15 minutes) AC, BI, CAC, CADI, DD, ECS, or EW waiver client.</p> <p>S5160 - Emergency response system-installation and testing - AC, BI, CAC, CADI, DD, ECS, or EW waiver client.</p> <p>S5161 - Emergency response system-service fee, per month - AC, BI, CAC, CADI, DD, ECS, or EW waiver client.</p> <p>S5162 - Emergency response system-purchase - AC, BI, CAC, CADI, DD, ECS, or EW waiver client.</p> <p>T1016TF UC - Waiver case management by paraprofessional - AC, BI, CAC, CADI, DD, ECS, or EW waiver client.</p> <p>T1016UC - Waiver case management - AC, BI, CAC, CADI, DD, ECS, or EW waiver client. 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Push/Pull	Push/Pull: This part of SSIS is no longer being used by any statewide agency. The functionality has been removed. Some users may still have an old Push/Pull icon included with their SSIS installed desktop shortcuts. If the icon is clicked SSIS will update to the current version, but a "SSISPP.EXE is no longer supported." message will display.
Security	Security in SSIS Administration: 1. Supervisors can now be added to the Unit List, without an error message displaying. 2. Assigned Users can now be added to the Department List without first saving the screen, and no error message displays.
Table Viewer	Table Viewer: is now available from SSIS Administration Tools menu. It is no longer a stand-alone SSIS application. Users with Administer system Role/Function can access Table Viewer. A new Table Viewer security Role/ Function will be implemented during the Pilot.
Vulnerable Adult	Referral tab: MAARC Call Center reports sent to Emergency Protective Services (EPS) agencies now display the correct Lead Investigative Agency (LIA). EPS agencies receive the report, and the "Adult Protection Services" section displays the EPS information.
Vulnerable Adult	Adult Maltreatment Report: The "Received By Phone" field is no longer required to complete a report and intake.
Vulnerable Adult	Adult Maltreatment Report: A new field labeled "Web Report #" now displays on the Adult Maltreatment Report tab. This field populates with information sent from the MAARC Call Center when the report originates from the website.
Vulnerable Adult	Adult Maltreatment Report: A new tab labeled "Victim Information" now displays on the Adult Maltreatment Report. Victim-related fields from the "Adult Maltreatment Report" tab now display on the new tab, in addition to the following new fields: 1. Needs Assistance 2. Receives Services
Vulnerable Adult	Adult Maltreatment Report: A new tab labeled "Impact/Effect on VA" now displays on the Adult Maltreatment Report. At least one checkbox must be selected in order to complete the Adult Maltreatment Report.
Vulnerable Adult	Allegations tab: Reports received from the MAARC Call Center, with only an "Alleged perpetrator description" on an allegation, now display selections in the "Allegation detail" box.
