# **Abuse in Later Life Advanced Law Enforcement Trainers**

## **Dr. Laura Mosqueda**

Laura Mosqueda, M.D., is a Professor of Family Medicine and Geriatrics at the Keck School of Medicine of USC, where she serves as the Associate Dean of Primary Care and the Chair of the Department of Family Medicine. She is the Director of the National Center on Elder Abuse, housed at the University of Southern California.



Dr. Mosqueda founded the first Elder Abuse Forensic Center in the United States and continues to see victims of abuse and neglect in the field. She has taught professionals in many fields including medicine, criminal justice, and social services. Dr. Mosqueda has published extensively in scientific journals and text books.

## **Jason Olson, MBA, CPA/CFF, CFE, CFI**

This workshop will provide insight on how forensic accounting is used in financial exploitation cases. Jason will walk us through past financial exploitation cases and provide information on forensic accounting, where to start with an investigation, what to look for, how to identify what is missing, how to summarize findings and how forensic investigative tools can assist with investigations.

Jason Olson is a partner in the forensic services division of Eide Bailly. Jason has over a decade of experience as a forensic accountant. Jason focuses on fraud prevention, detection and investigation services for civil, criminal and insurance recovery purposes. Jason has investigated over several hundred cases with loss amounts ranging from \$5,000 to over \$13 million.

Jason is a Certified Public Accountant, Certified Fraud Examiner, Certified Forensic Interviewer and Certified in Financial Forensics. He holds a master of business administration in economic crime and fraud management from Utica College founded by Syracuse University.
