

## Promoting Person-Centered Practices in HCBS: Incentives

1. [Quality Add-Ons](#): Provides a funding incentive for providers to plan and implement a quality improvement project to improve the quality of life of people served and the quality of services they receive.
2. Local Planning Grants: This grant supports MN lead agencies and service providers to develop alternatives to congregate living, including corporate foster care, within persons with disabilities available waiver resources.
3. [Live Well at Home Grant](#): This grant aims to expand the capacity of long-term services and supports to help people age 65 and older stay in their homes and communities of choice.
4. Innovation Grants: This grant will provide funding to achieve integrated competitive employment, integrated settings, and other outcomes determined by the commissioner. This grant program is in development and more information will be available in 2016.
5. [HCBS Performance-based Incentive Payment Program](#): This program received one-time funding to provide grants to HCBS providers to implement quality improvement projects that improved the lives of people served and the quality of services people receive.
