



ACRE certified customized employment training

Classroom training announcement

The Association of Community Rehabilitation Educators (ACRE) training is required for providers who offer customized supported employment services to Moving Home Minnesota (MHM) participants through the Money Follows the Person (MFP) demonstration. Providers will learn to use defined customized employment tools and techniques to help people with disabilities gain competitive employment positions. To provide MHM services, selected* individuals are required to complete this 40-hour training. Participants must attend all sessions, commit to a specific process and pass the post-test with a score of at least 80 percent.

* Each training session is limited to 18 people. Selection will be based on the diversity of the service delivery areas needed for supported employment services (SES) in MHM.

Target Audience

Supported employment service staff who has access to multiple funding streams for employment planning and employment support services. They must:

- Hold a current license for supported employment services in 245D
- Be a community rehabilitation provider or limited use vendor with Vocational Rehabilitation Services (MN VRS)
- Be willing to become an employment network in Ticket To Work (TTW)

Learning objectives:

- Develop an individualized approach to employment planning and job development
- Utilize a “one person at a time – one employer at a time” approach
- Provide strategies to individualize and match the strengths, conditions, and interests of a candidate to the needs of an employer
- Learn to personalize the employment relationship between a candidate and an employer in a way that meets the needs of both.
