How Adult Day Programs Can Institute Quality Improvement Measures to Reduce Hospital Readmissions

Description

This is the second in a series of three sessions focused on Quality Improvement and Adult Day Programs. Cindy Kauffman from The Institute on Aging in San Francisco will examine the ways in which hospitals and adult day providers can work together to help reduce hospital readmissions. Adult day providers are often the first to notice changes in participants and can serve as a first line of defense to prevent avoidable readmissions. This session will focus on the systems that will support this effort and tools to monitor changes in participants who are at risk of readmission.
