## Positive Support Community of Practice: Introduction to the Positive Supports Rule; Minnesota Rule 9544

### Description

On August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2015, a new administrative rule took effect. The rule manages the use of positive support strategies and creates new requirements regulating the use of restrictive interventions for all providers licensed under Minnesota Statutes chapter 245D and all other DHS-license holders serving a person with a developmental disability or related condition.

During this session, DHS representatives will cover the requirements that DHS-licensed providers must follow when implementing behavioral interventions. Topics will include:

- positive support strategies,
- prohibited, restricted and allowable procedures,
- updates to the Behavior Intervention Report Form,
- and new requirements for developing a Positive Support Transition Plan.

This is the second of two sessions covering this topic. The first was on August 11<sup>th</sup>, and this is the same presentation intended for those who were not able to view the first.
