The Positive Supports Rule (MN Rule 9544)

Description

The Positive Supports Rule creates requirements to use positive supports strategies with:

- persons receiving a 245D-licensed service, and
- all persons with a developmental disability or related condition served by any DHS-licensed service or facility.

The rule prohibits the use of certain restrictive interventions and places limitations on the emergency use of manual restraint.

This course is to help you understand how this rule is influencing services licensed by the Department of Human Services. This training will provide:

- an introduction to the Positive Supports Rule
- Information on positive support strategies and person-centered planning
- An overview of prohibited and allowed procedures in the Positive Supports Rule
- The roles of professionals in the Positive Supports Rule
- Documentation and Reporting in the Positive Supports Rule

This training also serves as the Commissioner's competency assessment for qualified professionals.
