¹ 245D-HCBS program license means the license the provider must hold to provide any service that requires a 245D license.

² Revenues means revenues derived from the provision of services that require licensure under chapter 245D. For example, revenue from GRH payments would not be included as GRH funds are not used to pay for 245D services.

³ Facility controlled by the provider means the provider is the owner, lessor, or tenant of service site.

⁴ 245D-CRS means a community residential setting license issued under 245D. The 245D-CRS license holder is required to hold a 245D-HCBS program license. The 245D-CRS license replaces the AFC license when the license holder does not live in the home and is providing 245D licensed services to the residents of the home.

⁵ 203-AFC means an adult foster care license issued under DHS Rule 203.

⁶ 2960-CFC means a child foster care license issued under MN Rules, chapter 2960.

⁷ SLF means a Supervised Living Facility license issued by the MN Dept. of Health.

⁸ 245D-DSF means a 245D Day Services Facility license issued under 245D. The 245D-DSF license holder is required to hold a 245D-HCBS program license.
