Roommates Minnesota

**A new online
person-to-person
roommate matching service
for people with disabilities**

Minnesotans with disabilities can now use this new online service to find others with disabilities who seek a housing solution.

What is Roommates?

Roommates matches a person with disabilities with other people with disabilities who are either:

- Seeking one or more roommates who have an interest in getting together to buy or rent an apartment, condo, or house
- Seeking one or more roommates to share a house or apartment a person already has.

Roommates is a safe method to find others seeking a housing solution. No identifying information is shared online and only preapproved individuals can use the service. Contact information shared only after people have expressed an interest in learning more about a listing. It is then up to interested parties to connect.

Consumers may use this service entirely by themselves or may ask a family member, friend, case manager or direct care worker to assist them.
