CDCS - Related Changes to the LTC Screening Document for CAC, CADI and TBI Waivers

To implement the Consumer Directed Community Supports (CDCS) service across all waiver programs effective April 1, 2005, the following instructions are applicable when completing the LTC Screening Document for the CAC, CADI and TBI Waiver programs when a person chooses CDCS:

For a person opening to the CAC, CADI or TBI Waiver and choosing CDCS:

- Use activity type 02, 04 or 07 (if within 60 days of a face-to-face assessment)
- Use assessment result 01, 10, 11, 28
- Enter a Y in the "CDCS" field on ALT4

Note: This will create a waiver span for the person.

For a person already on the CAC, CADI or TBI Waiver and newly choosing CDCS:

- Use activity type 07
- Use assessment result 98
- Enter a Y in the "CDCS" field on ALT4

Recent MMIS changes **now** allow using activity type 07 with assessment result 98 for this purpose. Screening document edits 780 (Assessment Result is Invalid), 642 (Activity Type 07 Invalid) and 643 (Activity Type/Assessment Result is Invalid) have been modified to accommodate the change.

Note: This will **not** extend the waiver span for the person.

For a person already on the CAC, CADI or TBI Waiver at reassessment time, who choose CDCS:

- Use activity type 06
- Use assessment result 13
- Enter a Y in the "CDCS" field on ALT4

Note: This will extend the waiver span for the person.

If a person chooses to discontinue CDCS at the time of their reassessment:

- Use activity type 06
- Use assessment result 13
- Enter an N in the "CDCS" field on ALT4

Note: This will extend the waiver span for the person.

If a person chooses to discontinue CDCS at any time **other** than their reassessment:

- Use activity type 07
- Use assessment result 98
- Enter an N in the "CDCS" field on ALT4

Note: This will **not** extend the waiver span for the person.
