


## Minnesota ACO Baseline Assessment Report - Appendix A: Survey Participation


### Web-based Survey

To maximize participation from the broader healthcare delivery network, the Economic Policy division of the Department of Health reached out electronically to health plans, providers (primary and specialty), hospitals and clinics. In all, 30 health plan contacts and 409 provider contacts were explicitly invited to participate in the survey. As requested within the email from MDH, the survey may have been forwarded as appropriate to the individual who would be responsible for completing the survey. Although there was no explicit request as part of the email communication to ensure a single response per provider/plan organization, many email recipients indicated they coordinated a single response in feedback provided to MDH.


**MDH received 65 on-line survey responses representing providers and 8 survey responses representing health plans.**



Within the provider survey participants, primary care, specialist, integrated delivery and hospital organizations largely represent the participating organizations.



Considering 2013 census data, participation was consistent with population distribution across the distinct Minnesota geographies.

BlueCross/BlueShield, HealthPartners and Medica cumulatively represent 85% market share within the fully-insured market sector. Separately, UCare represents the top HMO in Minnesota as measured through both the number of enrollees and revenue. Together with HealthPartners, Medica and BluePlus, more than 90% of the HMO market is
